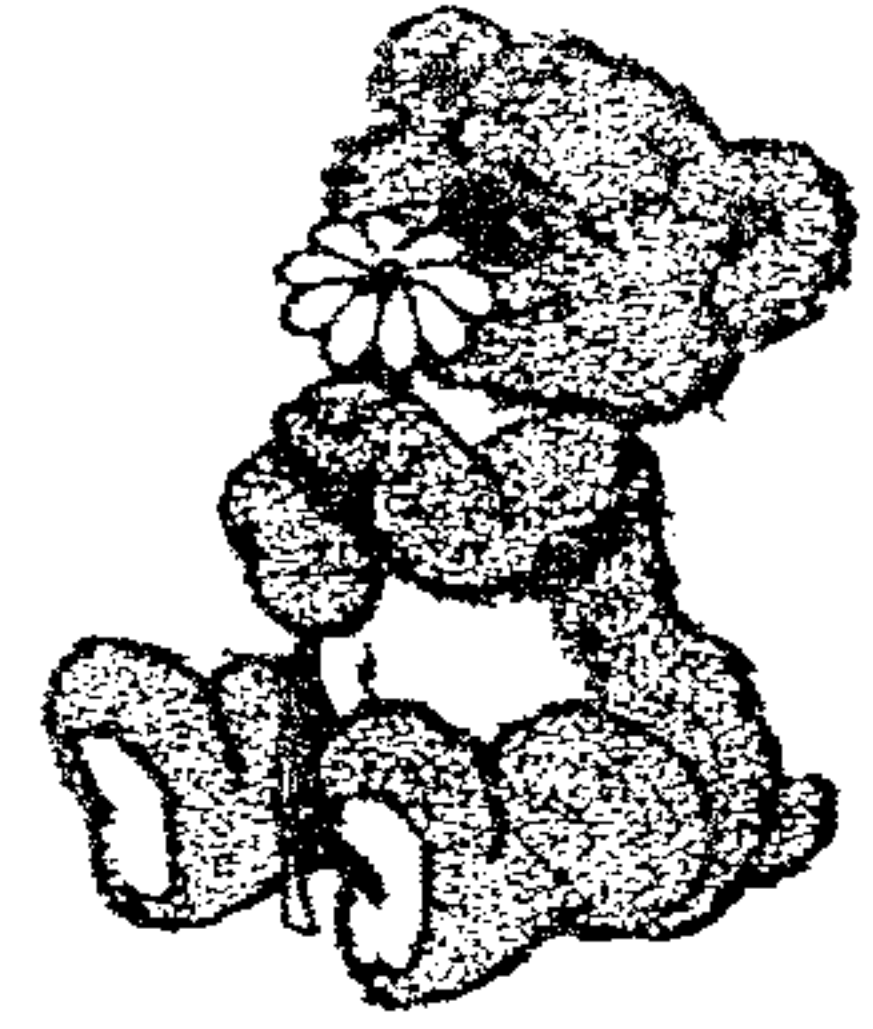

**Toilet Teaching Without Tears**



**Rates:**

\$25 ..... per week for Potty Training

The amount shown on this agreement is due even though your child may not be in my care due to illness or vacation. This contract is based upon my working the same hours and days as agreed upon for regular day care.

Toilet learning takes teamwork between parent, child, and child care provider. Success depends on parents, understanding adults and a child who is physically, intellectually, and emotionally ready, between the ages of 24 and 30 months.

**Signs of Toilet Learning Readiness**

- Can understand and follow simple directions
- Can dress and undress self
- Can run and climb easily
- Wakes up with a dry diaper after sleeping
- Expresses an interest in using the toilet
- Expresses an interest in their bowel movement

**Common Difficulties**

- Birth of a new baby
- Entering a child care setting
- Moving
- An adult leaving the home
- Illness
- Death of a loved one, including a pet

Remember, toilet learning is not a race or contest. Now that you and your child are ready to begin, you might want to set aside a weekend to start your training. My knowing this ahead of time allows me to change my day care routine to make time for your child's potty training. Cloth underpants should not be used until your child stays unsoiled all day. Pullups work, but must be treated as underpants, not diapers.
